Instructional Activities - These activities can be redone if a student wants to improve their score.

- Spiral Reviews
 - These are always due on Fridays, and they cover items that we have already learned. These items will not be on their upcoming test. We just give these worksheets to help the students retain information learned throughout the year.
- Warm ups
 - Questions that review old problems, current problems, and prepare them for standardized tests.
- Daily work:
 - You will get practice work on most days. Once it is assigned you have one day to try it on your own. The next day we will have question and answer time to go over anything you got stuck on. Then you have one more night before it is actually due.
